

- Current SCBWI members across the region are invited to submit their design to represent the exceptional talent and limitless possibilities our region has to offer!
- Preview Image Size: 150 dpi and 1600 px 2000 px width (so it's consistent for everyone).
- Please do not add the SCBWI logo or region name to your artwork submission.

Ithaca ShopTalk

For SCBWI folks close to Ithaca, join us on Wednesday, October 22nd, from 6:45-7:45PM in the Schwarz-Jacobsen room at the Tompkins County Public Library for our fall Ithaca Shoptalk meeting. Our focus will be on workshopping characters from current manuscripts, so come with a character in mind from a project you're working on and we will have a meet and greet (with that character) and do some interviewing to help you with character development. Try to think of some questions ahead of time, for instance: What's this character's favorite color and why? What scares this character? What's in this character's backpack? Who is this character's best friend?

Query Corner:

TIP #4.5: Adapting your Query Letter as an Author-Illustrator

- Your First Impression Introduction:
 - I am an author-illustrator seeking representation...
 - I am an illustrator seeking representation (wordless PB)...
 - Mention any illustration related connection; critique, presentation, social event
- Pitch and Summary no changes (see September newsletter)
- Description of PB and Comp Titles
 - It is here where you can add descriptive qualities of illustrations
- BIO
 - · Art and illustration background, and experiences that are important to you
 - Mention active memberships, critique groups, etc...
- Sharing your PB dummy
 - · Your website page with password
 - File Sharing like; Dropbox, WeTransfer, etc.
 - · Upload to online portal at agency website


Bike, Little Bike, written by Kellie DuBay Gillis, was juried and selected to be included in The Original Art 2025:


Order of the Night Jay by Jonathan Schnapp




